Purpose Statement

The purpose of the Homework Room Teacher position at Mount Tabor UMC Afterschool Care is to help teach the power of God's love in an affordable and quality program. The teacher will enhance the experience with daily devotions to help children grow spiritually in their faith. Teachers will use activity based learning to reinforce the knowledge and skills needed for school, as well as life. Through faith based leadership; children will develop a sense of self-esteem, self-worth and self-respect.

Position Qualifications

- High School Diploma or GED
- Minimum age requirement is 18 years old
- Demonstrate a strong faith in Jesus Christ in life and practice
- Early Childhood/BSAC Credentials or Certificate (preferred)
- 2 years of previous Afterschool employment (preferred)
- Criminal Background and Check (to be provided)
- First Aid and CPR training (to be provided)
- Safe Sanctuaries Training (to be provided)

Areas of Responsibility

Engage

- Engage Kindergarten-6th graders daily in a faith based, inclusive and theme based classroom
- Foster relationships with coworker and families of the children in the program
- Be attentive to the needs of the children

Equip

- Maintain necessary school supplies for students to complete their homework
- Attend scheduled staff meeting and staff development training opportunities

Empower

- Provide classroom leadership that encourages cooperation, learning and creativity

Execute

- Easily adapt to change, while still keeping the students interest and maintaining safety
- May be asked to help serve a provided snack daily to students, keeping in mind food allergies
- Operate following policies and expectations
- Sanitize all common surfaces in classroom, including sweeping/vacuuming the floor
- Be regular and punctual in attendance for all days of operation
- Be creative in classroom management
- May be asked to sub in another classroom
- May be asked to assist another teacher while in a group setting

Accountability

- This person is accountable to the Afterschool Director and Assistant Director in all areas

Salary/Benefits Package**Salary and hours**

- Hourly pay is \$9-11, based on education and/or experience
- Part-time, no more than 20 hours per week (Monday-Friday)
- Hours will fall between 1:45 PM-6PM

Other Benefits

- 7 paid holidays
- Paid Time off, based on days and hours scheduled to work
- Program is closed on inclement weather days if WSFCS are closed or closes early
- Program only operates during the WSFCS school year
